

How to become a Trusted Partner on Net4Log?

Q: Who is eligible to become a Trusted Partner with Net4Log?

A Registered Partner can elevate their status to a Trusted Partner by submitting an online application. Please note that the Trusted Partner program involves a fee, which is set by the core management team of Net4Log.

Q: How do I apply to become a Trusted Partner with Net4Log?

Follow these steps to complete your Trusted Partner application:

Step 1: Log in as a Registered Partner.

Step 2: To access your profile, click the three vertical lines in the top-left corner of the homepage, then select **Partner World**. Within Partner World, you'll see three options — click **My Profile** to continue.

Step 3: Click the **Profile Details** heading. Your profile information is automatically captured. Additionally, you have the option to include your VAT/GST ID for added convenience.

Step 4: Click the **Office & Location** heading to provide your office details, locations served (mandatory), contact information, and social media links.

Step 5: Click the **Service Details** heading to provide information about the services your company offers, such as FCL, LCL, air freight, and more. (listing all your services mandatory).

Step 6: Click the **Key Clients** heading to provide details about at least five of your current clients.

Step 7: Click the **Business Volume** heading to provide information on your business volume across transportation modes, including sea, air, and road.

Step 8: Click the **Company Finance** heading to provide your company's turnover in USD for the past two years.

Step 9: Click the **Corporate Information** heading to provide your company logo, corporate information, shareholders, directors, and group companies.

Step 10: Click the **My Documents** heading to upload the following required documents:

- Certificate of Incorporation / Registration Certificate / Articles of Incorporation / Business License
- Audited P&L and Balance Sheet financials (2 years); personal audited financials (for start-up companies)
- Articles of Association and Memorandum of Association
- Bank statements (last 6 months)
- Directors' Share Certificate
- Customs Department License
- Address proof (government-issued document or utility bill)
- Rental Agreement / Property Ownership Certificate
- Valid ID of company directors
- Employee details (minimum 2, maximum 5 employees)

Step 11: Submit your application.

Step 12: To check your Trusted Partner application status, click the three vertical lines in the top-left corner of the homepage, then select **Partner World**. Within Partner World, click **My TP Application** to view your profile status. A blue checkmark means that section is complete; a red symbol means corrections are needed for that item.

Step 13: After reviewing your application, click **Next** to proceed to the payment gateway.

Step 14: The Net4Log admin team will conduct KYC checks and either accept or reject the application.
